MASL D319325 - Ebola for UN Peacekeepers

2 days, class size 100

- ◆ Recognize people with Ebola, demonstrate Personal Protective Equipment wearing and removal
- ◆ Patient triage, movement & transfer
- ◆ **Audience:** Peacekeeping troops & commanders

MASL D319329 - Medical Readiness Principles of Food Protection

5 days, class size 30

- ◆ Food safety / defense capability for force health protection to decrease the risk of food borne disease
- ◆ **Audience:** Personnel involved with food / water

- ◆ Pre and post deployment: readiness, health threats screenings to protect the strength of deployed forces

- ◆ Addresses risks from dangerous pathogens
- ◆ Covers risk assessment, exercises, responsible science, Biological Weapons & Toxins Treaty obligations
- ◆ **Audience:** National security, medical planners, lab directors, public health & epidemic response officials

2 - 5 days

- ◆ Survey, assess needs, formulate future medical training needs & establish sustainable programs
- ◆ Jointly develop a plan of cooperation, which outlines the training objectives and matches those with training events
- ◆ Includes monitoring, evaluation & DOTMLPF assessment
- ◆ **Audience:** Our partner nations' facilities
